FASC will be hosting its annual Ski-a-Thon fundraiser Saturday, April 14, from 11 am until the lift closes. We look forward to seeing all athletes join in the fun. Participants are encouraged to solicit pledges for the number of vertical feet they ski between 11 am until close. Participants can pick-up their registration and pledge sheet at either FASC's Race Office at Ski Land or download forms at [www.fairbanksalpine.org](http://www.fairbanksalpine.org). Race bibs will be issued to all participants at the Race Shack office starting at 10:30 am the day of the event. **Racers meeting will be at 10:50 outside the Race office to go over the rules. If you are not at the meeting, you will not be able to participate in the Ski-a-Thon!**

## PLEDGE LEVELS:

**Denali Level - over 20,000 vertical feet (\$40.00)**

**Ski Land Level - between 10,000 and 19,000 vertical feet (\$20.00)**

**Snowplow Level - up to 9,000 vertical feet (\$10.00)**

It is alright to accept a flat pledge amount (dollar amount commitment) irrelevant of the number of vertical feet skied. All funds raised will go directly to supporting our program.

## **EVENT RULES:**

The format for the Ski-a-Thon will follow an "all in a day" format. Mighty Mites (Snowplow or Ski Land level) are encouraged to ski all the green runs and as many blue runs as possible. Juniors and Devos (Denali Level) will attempt to ski every main run on the hill. There will be event volunteers at the lift line checking off which run has been skied.

- Helmets required for all participants. No exceptions!
- On the day of the event upon registration, participants will be required to turn in their pledge sheet and pledge money.
- We need volunteers to rotate throughout the day at the top of the lift checking off each participant's runs, at the bottom of the lift to manage lift lines, and around the ski area. These folks will be the results officials.
- **No cutting in the lift line is allowed.** Participants are expected to wait in line just like everyone else. Skiers will be penalized a run for each reported violation of this rule to event official.
- One mandatory 30 minute break is required at 2 pm at the race shack.
- Awards for three top pledge gatherers!
